We strongly believe that school uniform gives our pupils a sense of identity and of belonging to the school. It helps to ensure that no child feels disadvantaged in terms of appearance, removes the need to keep up with constantly changing and expensive fashion trends, and instils a sense of pride. We expect all our school pupils to wear full school uniform and come to school

looking presentable each day.



Our School Uniform:

Autumn & Spring Term Uniform:

- EPS knitwear jumper (P&B)
- White shirt (long or short sleeved) or Polo Shirts
- Black/grey trousers, shorts, pinafore or skirts
- Black, safe, comfortable shoes (not trainers or boots)
- Plain red, grey or black tights, plain white, black or grey socks
- EPS Sun Cap (P&B)

Summer Term Uniform (as above plus):

 Red and white checked dresses in warm weather (with white socks only – no tights)

We provide the following compulsory items to pupils when they start school (Replacements via P&B)

- EPS Book Bag
- EPS Water Bottle

How to order uniform:

Items highlighted in blue above are **compulsory** purchases through Price & Buckland. The remaining items can be purchased from any shop e.g. Tesco, M&S etc.

For PE your child will need:

- A pair of <u>black</u> shorts, and/or <u>black</u>
 jogging bottoms, and/or <u>black</u> leggings
- An 'EPS logo' Sports T-shirt (P&B)
- A pair of <u>black</u> plimsolls and/or <u>black</u> trainers (no studded football boots)
- A black hoody or purchase an optional EPS Logo hoody or sweatshirt (P&B)
- Items named in a drawstring PE Bag

For Forest Schools or outdoor learning your child will need:

Old clothes with long sleeves and legs covered, long hair tied back, waterproofs when necessary, outdoor shoes/boots or wellies (need to be labelled)

Financial Support: For families who are eligible. for Free School Meals (Pupil Premium), the school will offer a financial contribution. Please contact the school office for more details. Details on Pupil Premium eligibility can be found <u>here</u>.

All clothing and belongings need to be named so we can easily return anything that is lost.

We ask that children <u>do not</u> wear jewellery of any kind expect for small studs (if ears are pierced), or wear nail varnish, makeup or tattoos. For health and safety reasons, long hair should be kept out of children's eyes and tied back, particularly for PE and Forest School sessions. Hair accessories should be plain and in school colours (red, grey or black). Extreme hairstyles such as very short or 'buzz cuts', sculptured names or symbols, or dyed hair, are neither appropriate nor acceptable for children of primary school age.
